Paint Brush



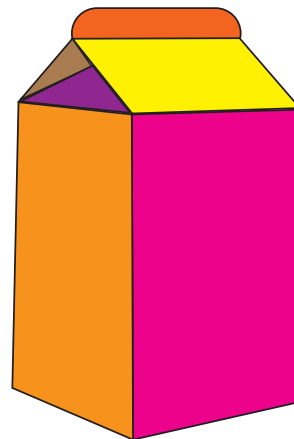
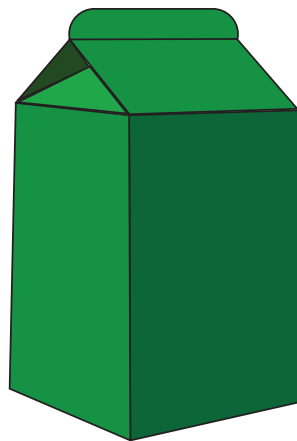
Milk



Drinking Straw

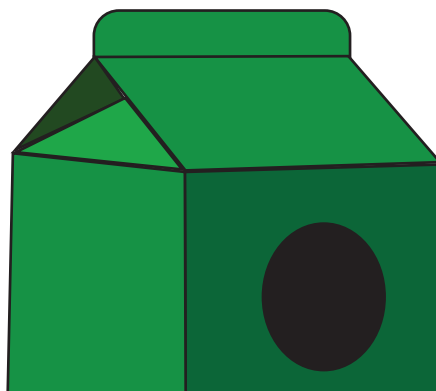

Begin by painting the milk container. Use your creativity; you can paint as plain or as creative as you would like.

Next, with scissors, carefully cut a circle out of one side of the milk carton. **REMEMBER!** *Any time a child uses scissors, there must be an adult present.* The hole will be the door for the bird who chooses to live in the house you are creating.

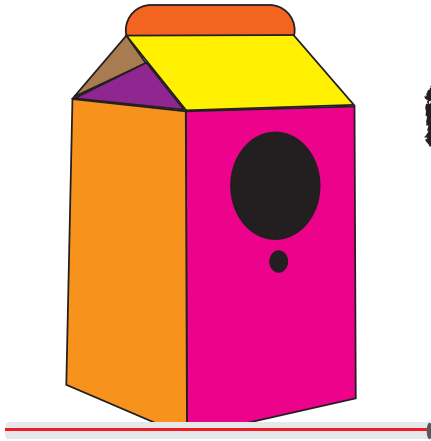

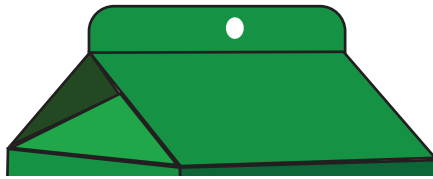

Carefully, with the scissors, make a small hole beneath the circle and put the drinking straw in the hole (the straw will serve as a perch for the bird).

Fourth, carefully make a small hole in the top of the milk container and thread the yarn through. Tie the two ends of yarn together, so there is a way to hang your birdhouse.

Finally, birds often nest close to the homes where people live, so make sure to hang the birdhouse close to your home; this improves the odds of a bird choosing the house you make.
