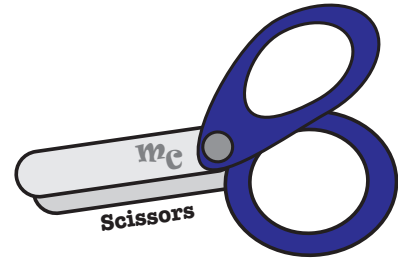
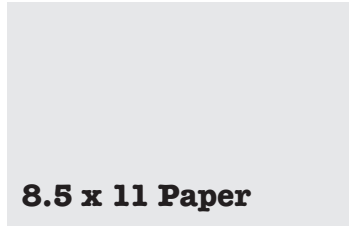


Paper Snowflake

You Will Need...



1.

Scissors are optional. You can tear the snowflake if you wish, or you might find it easier to use scissors. **REMEMBER!** *Any time a child uses scissors, there must be an adult present.*

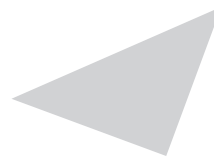
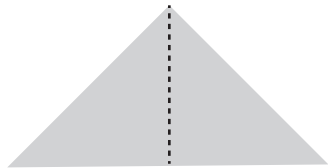

Start by folding the 8.5x11 paper into a triangle. Cut or tear the remaining rectangle part away. You can save that piece for another craft project.

Next, make a smaller triangle by folding the paper again.

Repeat the process, making an even smaller triangle.

Open the triangle once and fold one side in and the other side over. It should look like a rocket ship.

Finally, cut or tear the outside areas of the 'rocket ship' shape. Be careful not to cut or tear every folded area; otherwise, your snowflake will fall apart, and you will have to begin again. Once you have the shapes cut, unfold the paper to reveal the snowflake.
