The Crown of an Acorn

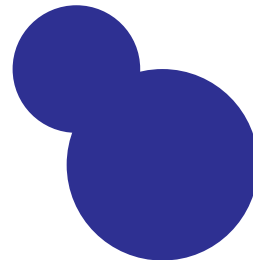
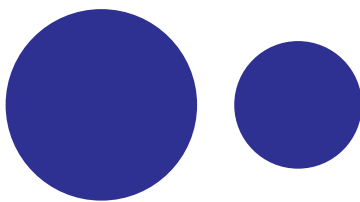
1.

Start by finding an acorn. Remove the crown of the acorn.



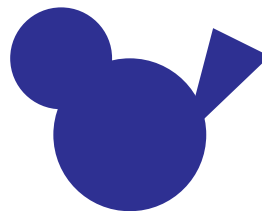

Next, roll a portion of clay into a ball. The ball should be big enough to fit into the crown of the acorn. Then, take some more clay and roll it into a smaller ball. Attach the smaller ball to the larger ball. The smaller ball will serve as the bird's head.

Now, take a little more clay and fashion a triangle. The triangle will serve as the bird's tail feathers. Attach the triangle to the back of the larger ball of clay.

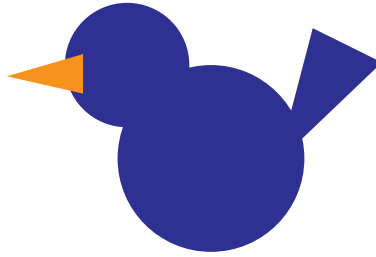

Using some of the orange clay, fashion a smaller triangle. This triangle will serve as the bird's beak. Attach the triangle to the front of the smaller ball of clay.

Then, take a little of the black clay and form two small circles. These circles will be the bird's eyes. Attach the eyes to the front of the smaller ball of clay above the beak.

Finally, place the bird into the crown of the acorn. The acorn will serve as the bird's nest.



NOTE TO ADULTS: *You can choose to use any color of clay. You can also use baking clay to make a more permanent decoration. If using baking clay, it might be best to bake the bird and remove it from the oven before attaching it to the acorn's crown. Children should never use hot appliances unattended.*
