
You Will Need...



- 1. Start with a nice-sized Scallop Shell for the body of your fish.

 Common Atlantic Abra Shells make excellent fins for your fish.
 - Next, select the color or colors of paint that you wish to paint your fish. For best results, paint your fish body and fins separately.
- The third step is patience. Now, you need to patiently wait for the paint to dry.
 - Fourth, decide how you want to put your fish together. Once you have it the way you want it, glue the shells together. You can also glue the googly eye on your fish.
 - Next, wait for the glue to dry. It could take a good deal of time, so you might want to move to another project and come back to your fish at a later date.

The final step is to decide if you want to make your fish into a refrigerator magnet, wall art, a puppet, or just a conversation piece. If you choose a refrigerator magnet, merely glue a magnet to the back of your fish. If you choose **wall art**, mount your fish in a shadow box for display. If you decide to make a **puppet**, attach your fish to a stick. Finally, if you want your fish to be a **conversation piece**, just leave the fish as is and show it to your friends.
